



Learning Objective:

- Ex: Birthdays, anniversaries, graduations, etc.




- The Liturgical year or Church calendar helps us celebrate <u>the life</u>, <u>death and</u> <u>resurrection of Jesus</u>.
- This is called the paschal mystery.




THE LITURGICAL CYCLE

- The Paschal mystery is celebrated <u>through</u> <u>specific seasons.</u>
- There are five specific seasons in the Church's calendar:
- Advent, Christmas,
 Ordinary Time, Lent and Easter.



- The Liturgical year is a <u>cycle of seasons</u> repeating itself at the end of each cycle.
- The Church year or cycle begins with
 <u>Advent</u> and ends with ordinary time.



- The Church calendar or Church year begins with the Holy season of Advent.
- The Church year begins in <u>late</u> <u>November or Early</u> <u>December.</u>
- Four weeks prior to December 25.




LITURGICAL YEAR
